After graduating from Sunnybank High, John-Paul studied dentistry at the University of Queensland.

As a small businessman and health practitioner, it was a strong sense of civic duty which led John-Paul into politics. He was elected as the State Member for Surfers Paradise in 2004. Since then, John-Paul has held numerous shadow ministerial portfolios including Health, Education and the Arts, Police and Corrective Services, Public Works and Housing, Employment and Training, Natural Resources, Mines and Energy. He has been a strong advocate in Parliament for improving the standard of Queensland's State Government.

John-Paul and his family have lived on the Gold Coast for more than 20 years. He is married to Stacey, with whom he has three children.
